



## Disability Policy

- St Cuthbert Wanderers Football Club is fully committed to ensuring that disabled supporters and customers have as full access as is reasonably possible to make all goods, services and facilities provided or offered to the public by the club.
- St Cuthbert Wanderers Football Club recognises that it has duties to remove any potential barriers that make it difficult or impossible for some disabled supporters to access our facilities. We will undertake such additional works as are reasonably required within the timescales set out in the Equality Act 2010.
- St Cuthbert Wanderers Football Club guarantees to its disabled supporters and customers that any complaints of discrimination will be dealt with quickly under that procedure. The club has advised all its staff and volunteers that any instance of discrimination under the provisions of the act is a serious matter and will be dealt with by the Club committee under its disciplinary procedure.
- St Cuthbert Wanderers Football Club will not tolerate abuse of less abled supporters or customers by other visitors to St Mary's Park. Should an incident of this nature be brought to the attention of the Club it will eject from the ground or withdraw from access to the ground to the abusive parties.
