GROUND REGULATIONS

1. All matches are played in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Scottish Football Association, Southern Counties FA and the South of Scotland Football League.
2. Play cannot be guaranteed to take place on any particular day or at any particular time and the Club reserves the right to change its advertised fixtures without prior notice and without liability.
3. The Club management reserves the right of admission to the ground. Any person currently subject of a football banning order or convicted of any football related offence will be refused admission.
4. In the event of a match being postponed or abandoned after having kicked off, any refund of admission will be at the sole discretion of the Club. This is subject to a time limitation, details of which can be obtained from the Club secretary. Persons entering the ground are advised to retain their ticket as this may be required to be produced at a later date.
5. Unauthorised persons are not permitted to enter upon the trackside, field of play or any other place specified by the Club or Police.
6. With the exception of authorised Media representatives holding accreditation issued by the club/event organiser, the taking of photographs or filming by any means inside the ground is prohibited. In addition, no transmission or reproduction, in whole or in part, in any form, or by any means, electronic, mechanical, recording or otherwise is permitted save with a special authorisation in writing by the club/event organiser and, where appropriate, any other relevant bodies.
7. Only persons specifically authorised in writing by the Club are permitted to offer Newspapers, Periodicals or any other Articles for sale in the Ground and any charitable collection will only be permitted within the ground with prior written consent of the club.
8. Unnecessary noise such as from the use of radio sets and behaviour likely to cause confusion, annoyance or nuisance of any kind, is not permitted in any part of the ground.
9. The use of threatening behaviour, foul or abusive language is strictly FORBIDDEN. Racial, sectarian, homophobic or discriminatory abuse or chanting is also forbidden and is considered as unacceptable conduct and may result in arrest and a lifetime ban from regulated football matches.
10. Please note that it is an offence punishable by law for any person to enter or attempt to enter the ground:
 - i. Whilst in possession of a prohibited container which is or was capable of holding liquid and which if thrown would be capable of causing injury to another person.
 - ii. Whilst drunk or in possession of alcohol
 - iii. Whilst in possession of any article or substance whose main purpose is the emission of a flare for purposes of illuminating or signalling or emission of smoke or a visible gas.
 - iv. Any article which is a fireworkand all persons entering the ground may be searched by the police.
11. Any person attempting to gain admission to, or being found within, a section of the ground designated for members only, without appropriate authorisation, may be ejected from the ground.
12. At all times the right of admission is reserved by the Club and in general no transfers within the ground are allowed. Spectators found in the wrong are without permission, may be ejected from the ground.

ALL PERSONS ENTERING THIS GROUND ARE ADMITTED ONLY SUBJECT TO THE ABOVE GROUND REGULATIONS AND TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCOTTISH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION, THE SOUTHERN COUNTIES FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION AND THE SOUTH OF SCOTLAND FOOTBALL LEAGUE.

ENTRY TO THIS GROUND SHALL BE DEEMED TO CONSTITUTE UNQUALIFIED ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS.

THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT FOR ITS SERVANTS AND AGENTS AND FOR MEMBERS OF POLICE SCOTLAND TO REMOVE FROM THIS GROUND ANY PERSON WHO DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS OR COULD REASONABLY BE CONSTRUED AS CONSTITUTING A SOURCE OF DANGER, NUISANCE OR ANNOYANCE TO OTHER SPECTATORS.
